


**The future of your Council, its services and our city ...**

*Our big challenge!*

Since the government cuts began in 2010, Derby City Council has had to cut millions of pounds year after year. In the last five years we have already cut £116 million and now we are required to make further cuts of £45 million by 2019.

£15 million**




# How we are funded

Council tax used to cover only a small part of the money needed to pay for all public services the Council provides. The majority of the money the Council received came from the government as a grant which we depended upon.

As the government continues to make cuts, we are being given less and less money to provide these services. Yet the cost of living is rising and poverty is increasing, meaning demand on our services is going up and up.



# Key pressures on our budget


Derby has more older people in need of help, more children coming into care and more pressure on school places. These are just some of the services the Council has to provide by law, but the money from government to provide them is reducing. The money available to provide services that are not required by law, known as discretionary services, will run out.



# Our big push for a 'Fair Deal for Local Government'

We have been telling the government how Derby has been unfairly affected by the cuts to our funding as part of the 'Fair Deal for Derby' campaign. For example, the impact of cuts per Derby resident is predicted to be a cut of £354 by 2017-18, compared to an increase per person of £57 in the West Oxfordshire constituency of the Prime Minister. We believe Derby's case is strong, we are lobbying the government regularly and will continue to ask for a Fair Deal across Local Government.


